The company works within the fields of industrial, furniture and graphic design. The firm was only established in late 2010, but Boris and Aleksej have been working together for a number of years. In 1987, Boris co-founded Komplot Design, where Aleksej was employed as an assistant for more than 11 years. This long and fruitful cooperation has allowed them to develop a shared philosophy of design. In their own words:"

"We wanted to design a compact but comfortable "family" of sofas that harked back to classic soft furniture styles – especially to the post WW2 period".





## **Basset**

Basset's sculptural language is simple and clear. There are just two elements – a horizontal "pillow" for a seat and a vertical "duvet" at the back that wraps around the seat, embracing it from the sides.

Upholstery details – marked piping is used to accentuate its shape in a natural way, giving it an easily recognizable design "signature".

Basset doesn't demand much space and fits easily into smaller rooms.

**Basset** is constructed and produced following the finest traditions of craftsmanship for this type of furniture.

### **Materials**

#### Back & arm section:

Belted wooden construction and polyether foam structure with supersoft foam padding.

#### Seat

Belted wooden construction with spring system and polyether foam structure with supersoft foam padding.

#### Legs:

Solid natural oak

Coda, Divina, Divina melange, Outback, Hallingdal, Tonus, Tonica

#### Gabriel:

Interglobe, Euro-post, Nobel, Luna
